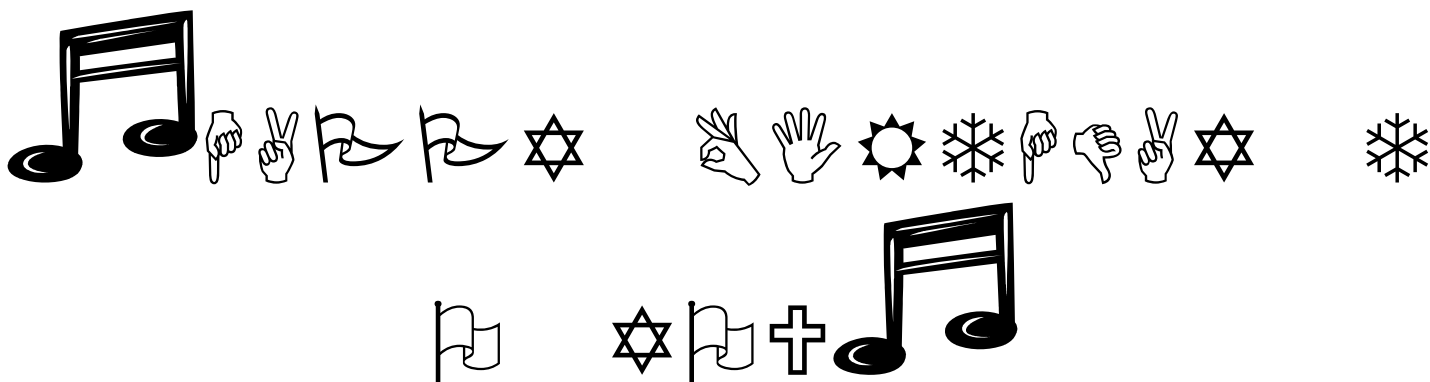
We had so much fun at the Great Chocolate and Wine Trail (and we bought so much wine), there is talk we may do this again next year. I vote "yes".
